

Dance of the Phoenix

September 9 - 10, 2006

Where: EarthSong Peace Chamber - Three Rivers, MI

Time: 1 PM on Saturday till late morning on Sunday

You are invited to a dance that holds the intention of assisting the movement from one state of consciousness or awareness to another - an initiation into the Greater Reality for self and the world. If you are called to this dance, you may be responding to the deeper call to oneness with the divine and for peace in the world. If you wish to dance your emerging, soul-infused life and the Earth into greater Being, please join us.

The vision for this dance included a glistening tear on the face of a Black Madonna, and dancers first mourn and release whatever belongs to the past, including limiting beliefs from both personal and the collective, in order to clear space for new life. At dawn we move into a dance of jubilation and celebration. The Phoenix has risen from the ashes.

Joseph Rael, the visionary for the peace chambers and many dances around the world, has blessed this dance. He said that he has long wanted the spirit of the Black Madonna - that archetypal spirit of the divine feminine that transcends any one culture -- brought to greater awareness. A sister peace chamber in Germany, inspired into being by Joseph, is next to a Black Madonna church. It is time for the uniting of the dynamic and magnetic or masculine and feminine aspects of us and to move beyond duality.

Dance of the Phoenix details:

We gather at 1 PM on Saturday, September 9. The afternoon is spent setting up tents, hanging and sharing banners, making items for the dance, and participating in a sweat lodge. We go into silence in the early evening as dancers retire to their tents. Awakened at 3 AM, dancers begin to the tune of drums and bagpipes. The dance ends sometime on Sunday morning, followed by a celebratory feast. Further instructions follow upon your registration.

The fee for this dance experience is \$150, and a \$50 deposit, refundable until August 31, will hold your place. A couple of partial scholarships are available in exchange for helping with the morning feast.
